SCoNe School Structure

Immersed in this intensive two-week program, participants will work alongside faculty members promoting theoretical and practical interactions. SCoNe School will be organized in two modules: *Neuroscience of Social Information Processing* (social judgment, empathy, stereotyping, prejudice, face perception and emotion), and *Neuroscience of Reward* (neurobehavioral mechanisms of appetitive motivation and reward, value-based decision making, and the rewarding value of social interaction).

Each one-week module will be organized in morning general-overview lectures and afternoon focused-tutorials on methods tied to social cognitive neuroscience.
