### Public Announcement

of a comparative evaluation procedure of curricula to assign the task of assessing the activities of the Master's Course in Science Communication "F. Prattico" of the International School for Advanced Studies of Trieste (approved by the Board of Directors of SISSA on 05/03/2015)

Given Art. 3, paragraph 2 letter c and Art. 11 of the Statute of the School;  
Given the decision of the Interdisciplinary Laboratory dated February 17, 2015 to appoint an assessment body for the activities of the Master's course in Science Communication;  
Given the requirement that the evaluation is carried out by external personnel;

### Declares

that SISSA must proceed to the identification of four members, external to the School, to be part of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Master's course in Science Communication "F. Prattico". The members will be selected among national and international experts in the field of training and research in science communication. The school intends to assign the Board the task of evaluating the activities of the Master's course, defining medium to long-term educational objectives and giving advices for possible improvements.

In particular, the Scientific Advisory Board will be engaged in the following activities:

- evaluating the performance and development plans of the Master's course, and, if necessary, the technical-administrative services;
- expressing their opinion on the quality of the training program, its adequacy with respect to the latest theories and practices in the current ecosystem of science communication, the role of the Master's course in the international context;
- evaluating the governance and leadership of the Master's course.

To finish, the Scientific Advisory Board will prepare a written report with their scientific and organizational recommendations and their evaluations.

### Term:

The position lasts for three years with effect from the date of appointment.

### Requirements:

On the last day for submission candidates must:

- enjoy civil and political rights;
- do not have any criminal record and not be recipients of measures relating to the implementation of preventive measures, civil decisions and administrative measures;
- be aware of not being subject to criminal proceedings;
- be highly competent and experienced in journalism, science communication, teaching, governance and leadership.

### Submission of applications:

Applications, addressed to the Director of SISSA, via Bonomea n. 265-34136 - Trieste, Italy, must be written on plain paper using the attached application form and be

accompanied by a curriculum vitae, the tax/benefit form and the copy of a valid identity document. They must be submitted to the Human Resources Office of SISSA by 12.00 pm on April 8, 2015 at with the following modalities:

- Registered mail, or by fax to 0039(0)403787240, together with a copy of valid ID;
- By hand, directly to the Human Resources Office of SISSA, in the following hours: Monday to Friday, from 8.30 am to 2.00 pm, except for the last day to submit, when applications will have to be received by 1.00 pm;
- By email to [ilas@sisssa.it](mailto:ilas@sisssa.it) within that period.

Applicants applying by e-mail, should send their application, the tax/benefit form and a CV in pdf format. All documents should be signed and sent together with the scan of a valid ID (both sides). Incomplete applications or applications received beyond the stated deadlines will not be considered.

**Commission o Evaluation board:**

A Commission, composed of three experts, will be nominated by the Director of the School, based on art. 5, paragraph 2, of the "Regulations for Outsourcing of collaboration assignments and research".

**Comparative evaluation procedure of curricula:**

The selection is done through comparative evaluation of the curricula on the basis of what stated by the candidates in the application and in the curriculum.

The school reserves the right to call the candidates for an interview; the possible convocation will be sent by e-mail.

**Evaluation results**

At the end of the selection, the Commission prepares the minutes indicating the evaluation results and thus identifying the four chosen subjects.

The selection proceedings are approved by the Director.

The assessment does not result in certification of competence.

The merit ranking of candidates will be published on SISSA website.

**Signature of the contract of assignment:**

Selected candidates will sign a coordinated and continuous collaboration contract lasting three years. The validity of the contract is subject to the preventive supervision of legality by the Auditors' Court.

**Honorarium:**

The honorarium for these four collaborations, inclusive of all costs, will be:

€ 600,00.- (six hundred/00) gross for candidates from the region of Friuli Venezia Giulia;

€ 1.000,00.- (one thousand/00) gross for candidates from Italy (except for the region of Friuli Venezia Giulia);

€ 1.600,00.- (sixteen hundred/00) gross for candidates from Europe (except for Italy);

€ 2.500,00.- (two thousand five hundred/00) gross for applicants from outside Europe.
